Interviews will begin at 6 p.m. Each contestant will be asked fire safety questions. Fire Prevention Materials pertaining to the interview questions will be given to each contestant prior to the interviews. The 2014 BFD Miss Flame and Runner up will be announced after all interviews are complete.

The contestant chosen to represent Belton Fire Department in the Bell County Miss Flame will need to attend the county competition and judging at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, September 30, at Bell County Communications Center.

The Bell County Miss Flame Crowning will be at 11 a.m. on Saturday, October 4.

MISS FLAME CONTEST RULES

- Must be a sophomore or junior in high school
- Last year's GPA must be 80 or better
- Must have attended at least one full semester at the high school she is currently attending
- Must not have any disciplinary action that resulted in detention or suspension the prior or current school year
- The application must be signed by a school representative verifying previous GPA
- Must reside within the fire district of the Belton Fire Department
- Applicant cannot be married upon entry of the contest nor can she be married during her reign, if selected as Miss Flame
- Title of Miss Flame can only be achieved one time per contestant
- A board selects the winner based on answers to 10 fire prevention questions (Judging will be at 6 p.m. on Sept. 23 at Station 2, 420 Sparta Rd.)
- The Belton Fire Department will provide applicants with fire prevention study materials prior to the convening of the interview board
- Miss Flame represents BFD in the Bell County Miss Flame contest at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 30, at the Bell County Communications Center
- Miss Flame represents BFD in the Bell County Miss Flame contest crowning at 11 a.m. on Saturday, Oct. 4
- The selected Miss Flame is expected to participate in the following fire prevention events:
 - BFD Annual Open House(10/11/14)
 - Christmas at the Park(12/6/14)
 - 4th of July Parade(7/4/15)
 - Any other similar events

Questions and other requirements will be addressed at the discretion of the Fire Chief
